

Chronic diseases

The flu vaccine is offered free of charge to people who have any of the chronic diseases listed below :

- Diabetes
- Anatomic of functional asplenia
- Immunodeficiencies condiditons (e.g. cancer, HIV infection)
- Chronic kidney problems or nephrotic syndrome
- Chronic cardiac or pulmonary disorders severe enough to require regular medical attention or hospital care
- Asthma severe enough to requise regular medical attention or hospital care
- Medical conditions that may affect the ability to expel respiratory secretions and the ability to swallow (e.g.: cognitive disorder, spinal cord injury, convulsive disorder, neuromuscular disorders)
- Chronic liver disease
- Anemia
- Hemophilia
- Morbid obesity (BMI \ge 40)
- Inborn error of metabolism
- Prolonged treatment with acetylsalicylic acid (For kids (under 18 years of age)
